- Perform hydrogeological field investigations including soil identification, test pitting, and surveying using total station or GPS equipment.
- Carry out surface water sampling, baseline water well sample collection, and inspection of private water and wastewater systems.

Construction Oversight & Site Inspections

- Supervise drilling and test pit contractors on active sites.
- Conduct on-site inspections for:
 - Waterproofing and foundation drainage installations
 - Slope stability and bedrock stabilization
 - o Retaining wall and shoring system construction
 - Rock grout anchor testing (pull testing)
 - Failure investigations

Field Testing & Quality Control

- Occasionally provide field testing services including:
 - Compaction and concrete testing
 - o Crack monitoring, lok testing, and thermocouple installation



- Flatness testing and road construction reviews
- Coring of rigid materials
